Fee waivers are valid until December 31st two years after the applicant became eligible. For example, if an applicant participated in the Big Ten+ Graduate School Expo in September 2014, he/she must apply and request the fee waiver by December 31, 2016. Fee satisfaction applicants are eligible to submit one application without a fee payment for a named program per year.
